JOINING AIFA

TO JOIN AIFA:

1. Apply for a firearms Licence at your local police station with the endorsements A1,B1 and H1.
2. Wait for a letter from Police approving you to hold a firearms licence.
3. Once you have received Police approval to hold a club licence, complete the application form enclosed and return both to AIFA
4. Pay the \$300 up front for A1, B1 & H1 training.
5. Commence training with AIFA
8 x practical assessments and a theory course booklet and assessment o complete .
6. Complete the club training course and documentation sent to SA Police.
7. Direct debit of \$45 per month commences including unlimited range and firearm hire.
8. Commence normal Club activities as an Ordinary AIFA member



PROCESS FOR GAINING A CLUB FIREARMS LICENCE

- 
1. Attend your local Police Station with 100 points of I.D.
 2. Complete the Firearms Licence Application form (PD303)
H1– Handgun Club Use
A1&B1 Rifle Shotgun Club Use
 3. Wait for the letter (28 days) from Police approving you to hold a licence
 4. Join the Club and undertake the training course
 5. Lodge the Club Certificate (PD314) with Police
 6. Once you receive your temporary licence go to Service SA and pay the licence fee and have your photo taken— You will receive your photo licence in the mail.

YOU MUST MAINTAIN YOUR MEMBERSHIP WITH A CLUB AND COMPLETE A MINIMUM 6 COMPETITIVE SHOTS TO MAINTAIN THIS LICENCE.
