



RESPONSIBLE SERVICE OF ALCOHOL (RSA)

SITHFAB201 - PROVIDE RESPONSIBLE SERVICE OF ALCOHOL

COURSE PURPOSE: This course incorporates the knowledge requirements under SA liquor licensing law, for employees engaged in the sale or service of alcohol. This can include the licensee and security staff. In SA this extends to “authorised” crowd controllers whom may also be nominated as the “Responsible Person”.

COURSE OUTLINE: Responsible sale & service of alcohol; assist customers to drink within appropriate limits; assess alcohol affected customers and identify customers to whom sale or service must be refused and refuse service of alcohol to those whom should not have alcohol sold or served to them. This course is suitable for security staff working at licensed premises. Includes scenario based assessments.

COURSE PRE-REQUISITES: Nil

AWARD: Statement of Attainment for “SITHFAB201 - PROVIDE RESPONSIBLE SERVICE OF ALCOHOL”

ATTENDANCE: Available attendance mode only as scheduled.

COURSE DURATION: 6.5 hours. (0900 - 1630hr)

COURSE FEE: \$95.00

AWARD: Statement of Attainment for Unit - SITHFAB201 - Provide responsible service of alcohol

CURRENCY: This course needs to be “refreshed” each 2 years in accordance with Liquor Licence Act 1997 for those (including security staff) working at licensed premises.
